

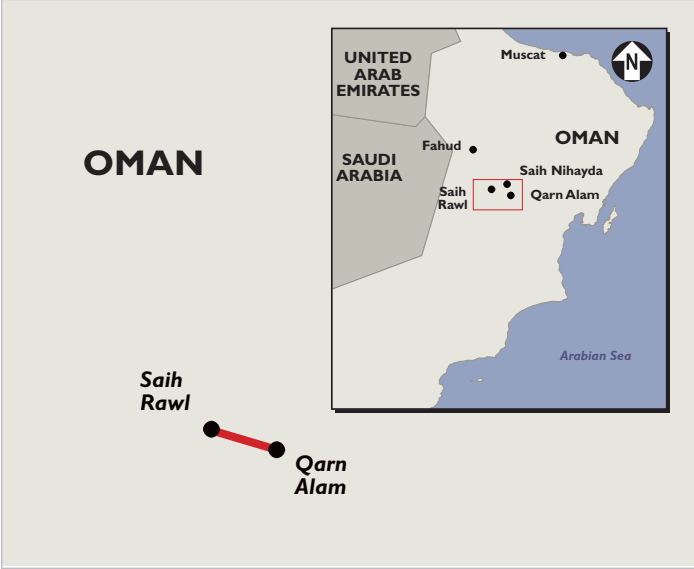
# Saih Rawl to Qarn Alam Pipelines

*Petroleum Development Oman (PDO)*

In March 1997, PDO awarded a contract to The Oman Construction Company, L.L.C. (TOCO), a Willbros' subsidiary, for the construction of the 47-km (29-mile), 10-inch pipeline from Saih Rawl to Qarn Alam in Oman.

In November 1997, PDO made two post-award amendments to the contract to include several additional pipeline segments. The first amendment involved various pipelines in the Fahud area, including the 22-km (14-mile), 8-inch Fahud West to Fahud D; the 2.4-km (1.5-mile), 12-inch Fahud C; and the 3-km (2-mile), 8-inch Fahud D pipeline replacements. The second amendment involved a 30-km (19-mile), 6-inch pipeline from Ghaba North to the Saih Nihayda Gas Treatment Plant.

The initial pipeline was completed in October 1997. The additional lines were completed in May 1998.
