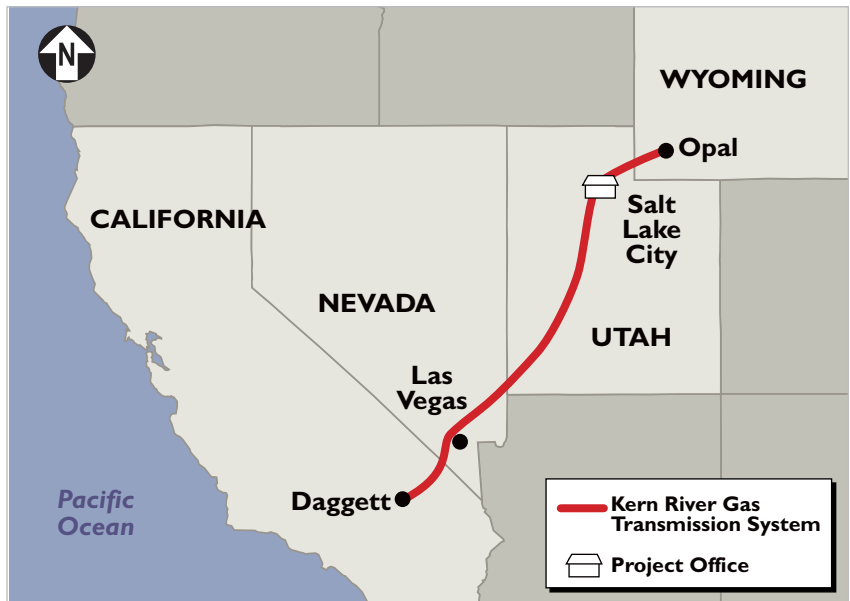


Willbros provided project management for the Kern River Gas Transmission Company's pipeline system. Kern River Gas Transmission Company is owned equally by Kern River Corporation, an affiliate of Tenneco, Inc., and Williams Western Pipeline Company, an affiliate of the Williams Companies. The system was developed to supply California with gas from the overthrust region of the Rocky Mountains and, with future expansion, Canada. The pipeline originates near Opal, Wyoming, and terminates in Southern California near the town of Daggett. The 1,102-km (685-mile), 36-inch line has a capacity of 700 MMscfd.

Included in the overall system are three compressor stations, measurement and maintenance facilities, a communication and data acquisition system, a project office in Salt Lake City, Utah, and a separate, jointly-owned and operated 30- and 42-inch pipeline system from Daggett to Bakersfield, California.

Willbros' scope of work included project management; detailed engineering; pre-construction field surveys; ROW acquisitions; preparation of alignment sheets, permit drawings, construction specifications, and bid documents; material receiving and control; and as-built surveys.

Willbros' work on this project was completed in 1992.
