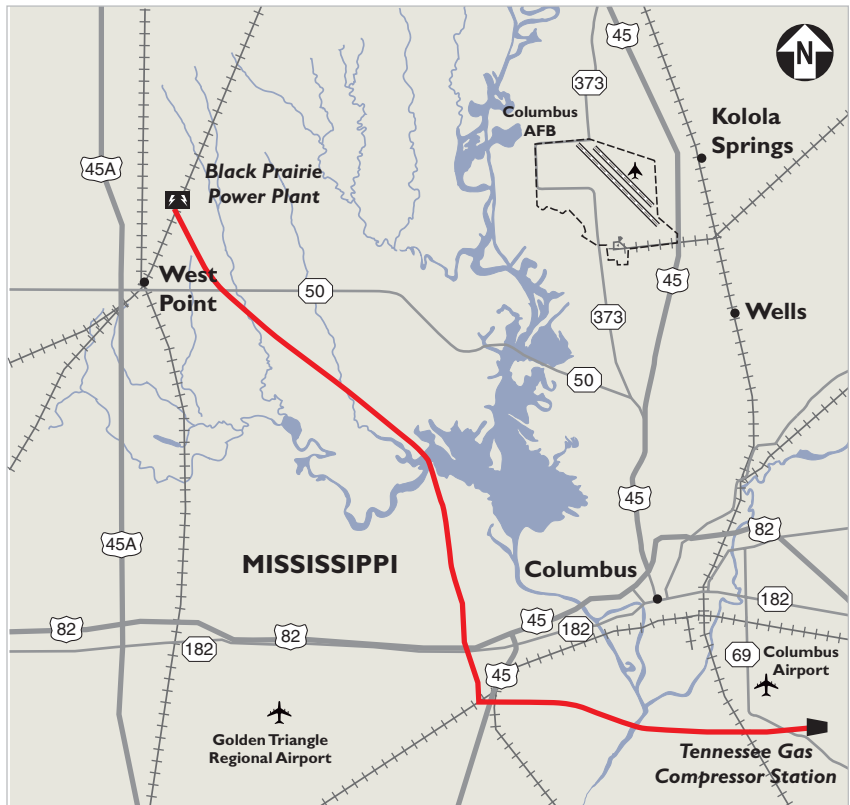


Panda Black Prairie Project

Panda Energy International, Inc.

The Black Prairie Project, a 1,300-megawatt merchant electric plant, is being developed by Panda Energy in West Point, Mississippi.

In April 2001, Willbros was awarded a contract for preliminary engineering and field services for a 25-mile gas transmission pipeline to fuel the facility. The 24-inch line will transport 216 MMscf/d of natural gas from an interconnect with Tennessee Gas Transmission Pipeline near Columbus, Mississippi, to the proposed power generating station.

Phase I services include route alternative analysis, route selection, surveying, mapping, right-of-way and environmental permitting support and the preparation of a RFP package for the Phase 2 EPC contract.

The plant was originally scheduled for service in 2004, but in May 2002, the project was placed on hold by Panda.
